The Department accepted Recommendation 2012-1 based on the issues and conditions at the time of issuance, as well as developed an implementation plan to address such issues and conditions. The Department does not intend to reevaluate its position on a six year old Recommendation for which it has already dedicated funding and resources. However, DOE acknoledges that the potential release in a design basis accident would challenge the EG threshold for ensuring adequate protection of the public health and safety.
