Dear Chair Connery:

The Department of Energy's National Nuclear Security Administration (DOE/NNSA) received your letter, dated July 20, 2022, regarding revisions to DOE-NA-STD-3016, proposed co-located unit operations, and expanded nuclear explosive operations at the Pantex Plant (Pantex).

The letter established a 60-day requirement to provide a briefing on how NNSA plans to maintain the positive trajectory of its previously communicated improvement initiatives for conduct of operations and organizational culture at Pantex during these operational changes. We value the Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board's (Board) concerns and insights on these topics.

Given the coordination efforts required to adequately address the Board's concerns, NNSA anticipates providing a briefing to the Board by November 23, 2022.
