A. <u>Bechtel Hanford, Inc. (BHI) Personnel Changes:</u> Steven Liedle, President of BHI, is being appointed President and General Manager of Bechtel Nevada. BHI Vice President and Manager of Operations Michael Hughes will take over as BHI President and Thomas Logan, currently the Manager of Decommissioning Projects, will become the Vice President and Manager of Operations. All appointments will be effective in early January 2000.

B. <u>Tank 101-SY Transfer:</u> Lockheed Martin Hanford Company is completing its corrective actions following the suspension of the DOE Readiness Assessment. Primary improvement activities are in the area of conduct of operations. It is expected that LMHC will re-declare readiness the first week in December.
